Practical information

Accommodation

We recommend the following hotels easily reachable from the Part-Dieu Station, where the Rhone Express (tramway shuttle between the airport and Lyon city) stops:

• Mercure Lyon Centre Charpennes

To reach LIP premises: take tramway line **T1** direction **IUT Feyssine** or line **T4** direction **La Doua Gaston Berger** and stop in **Condorcet.** Cross the Boulevard du 11 Novembre and you will see the building Atrium in front of you.

• Mercure Lyon Centre Brotteaux

Walk 5 minutes to reach Charpennes or take the metro line B direction Charpennes and stop in Charpennes, which is the terminus. Then take the tramway line **T1** direction **IUT Feyssine** or the line **T4** direction **La Doua Gaston Berger** and stop in **Condorcet.** Cross the Boulevard du 11 Novembre and you will see the building Atrium in front of you.

And cheaper options, at walking distance from the meeting venue but farther from Part Dieu Station / Lyon City center:

• Ibis Styles Lyon Villeurbanne Parc de la Tête d'Or

Cross the Boulevard du 11 Novembre 1918, take on the left and follow the bike lane. You will see the building Atrium immediately after crossing the tramway rails.

Hotel des Congrès

Head northwest on Pl. du Commandant Rivière toward Allée Julien Duvivier, turn right onto Allée. Julien Duvivier. Take the stairs, follow Av. Roberto Rossellini and then turn right onto boulevard du 11 Novembre 1918. Cross the boulevard, take Av. Pierre de Coubertin and immediately turn right into Bd André Latarjet. The building will be on your left.

Transportation

From Lyon Saint Exupéry Airport to Lyon Part Dieu station

From the airport to **Lyon Part-Dieu station, take the shuttle Rhône Express** (tramway to/from airport – 30 minutes trip):

Departure every 15 minutes from 04:25 to 00:00







Cost:

One way Ticket: $16,70 \in (15,20 \in \text{if you buy it online}) / Round Trip Ticket: <math>29,10 \in (26,70 \in \text{if you buy it online})$

Metro / Tramway tickets

The tickets for the metro and tramway are the same, and cost $2 \in$ each. They are valid for one hour and a return trip is allowed within this hour. You can buy them in every station using coins, notes or credit cards in automatic machines, or directly on the bus or tramway using your credit card or smartphone.

From Lyon Saint Exupéry Airport to ISA premises by taxi

By taxi: the trip can take 35 to 50 minutes and depends very much on traffic. The cost is about $65 \in$ to $90 \in$.
